Alterations & additions to Buoyage: Nos 22 & 24 & new buoy "B"

Mariners are advised that due to changes in the approach channel the following alterations to buoyage will take place on 12.03.24

- a) No 22 Light buoy to be moved to - Lat 52° 50.400'N Long 000° 21.780'E.
- b) No 24 Light buoy to be moved to - Lat 52° 50.017'N Long 000° 21.863'E.
- c) "B" buoy established in position - Lat 52° 50.133'N Long 000° 21.692'E.

Works will be carried out by the work boat "St Edmund".

All passing craft are requested to pass at minimum speed whilst the "St Edmund" is conducting buoying operations.
