Notice to Mariners 8/ 2025.

East Coast of England - The Wash

River Great Ouse – Wiggenhall St Peter.

Sunken Cabin Cruiser

Mariners are advised that on 12.05.25 a 9.75M LOA Cabin Cruiser sunk on the western edge of the river bank of the river Great Ouse at Wiggenhall St Peter. Original Position of sunken vessel 52°41'.527'N 000°22'.279'E.

On 13.05.25 the Harbour Authority visited the incident sight to commence salvage operations, however the vessel was not at that location and it is believed that the sunken vessel has shifted with the tidal flow.

A survey of the river for a search of the vessel has been completed on 13,14,15<sup>th</sup> May 2025 – The sunken vessel was not located. We believe that the vessel has settled within a deep pocket somewhere in the river.

We advise all Mariners that this is deemed to be a potential danger to navigation and that the river Great Ouse should be navigated with extreme caution.

We also recommend to navigate with a tidal height of at least 5.0 metres at all times.
